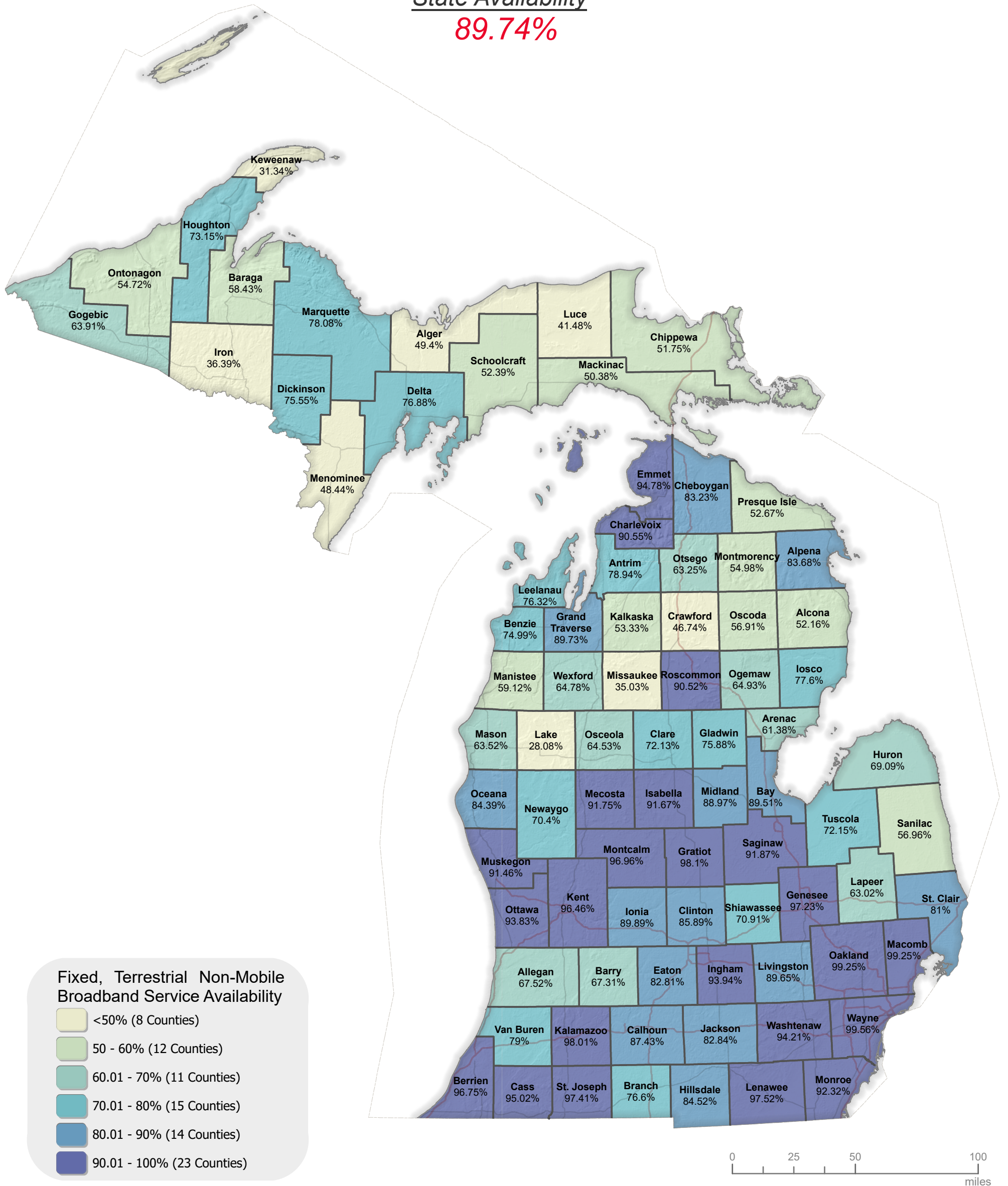


# Michigan Fixed Broadband Service Availability by County
