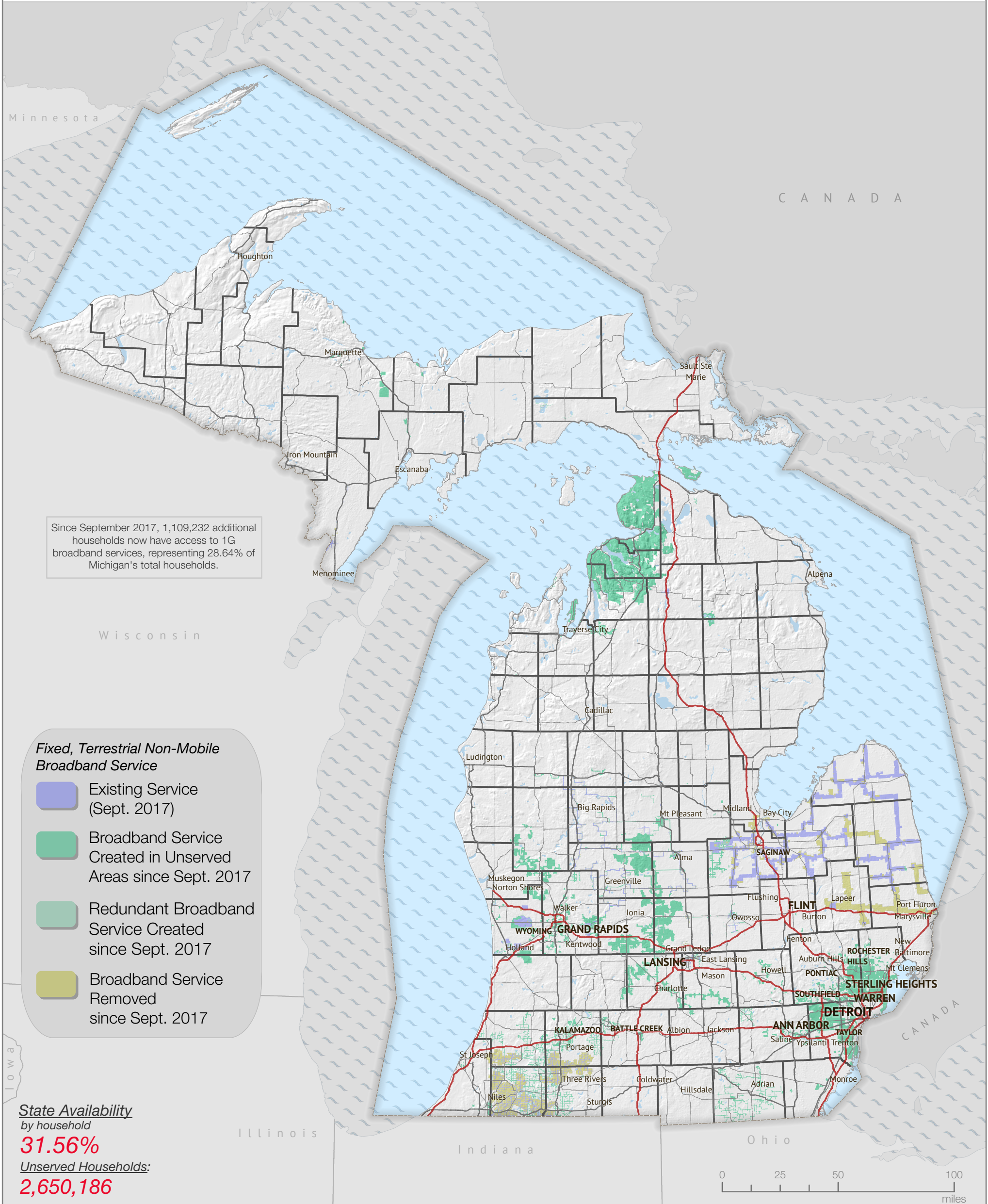


Broadband Growth

Changes in Fixed, Non-Mobile 1 Gbps Download Broadband Service since Sept. 2017



Broadband data displayed on this map are developed from a combination of direct provider outreach and data collection, FCC Form 477 broadband deployment filings, and independent research conducted by Connected Nation Michigan. If a broadband provider was unwilling or unable to supply granular data and a detailed service area could not be developed, the provider's service availability is represented by FCC Form 477 data, a format which tends to be overstated.
