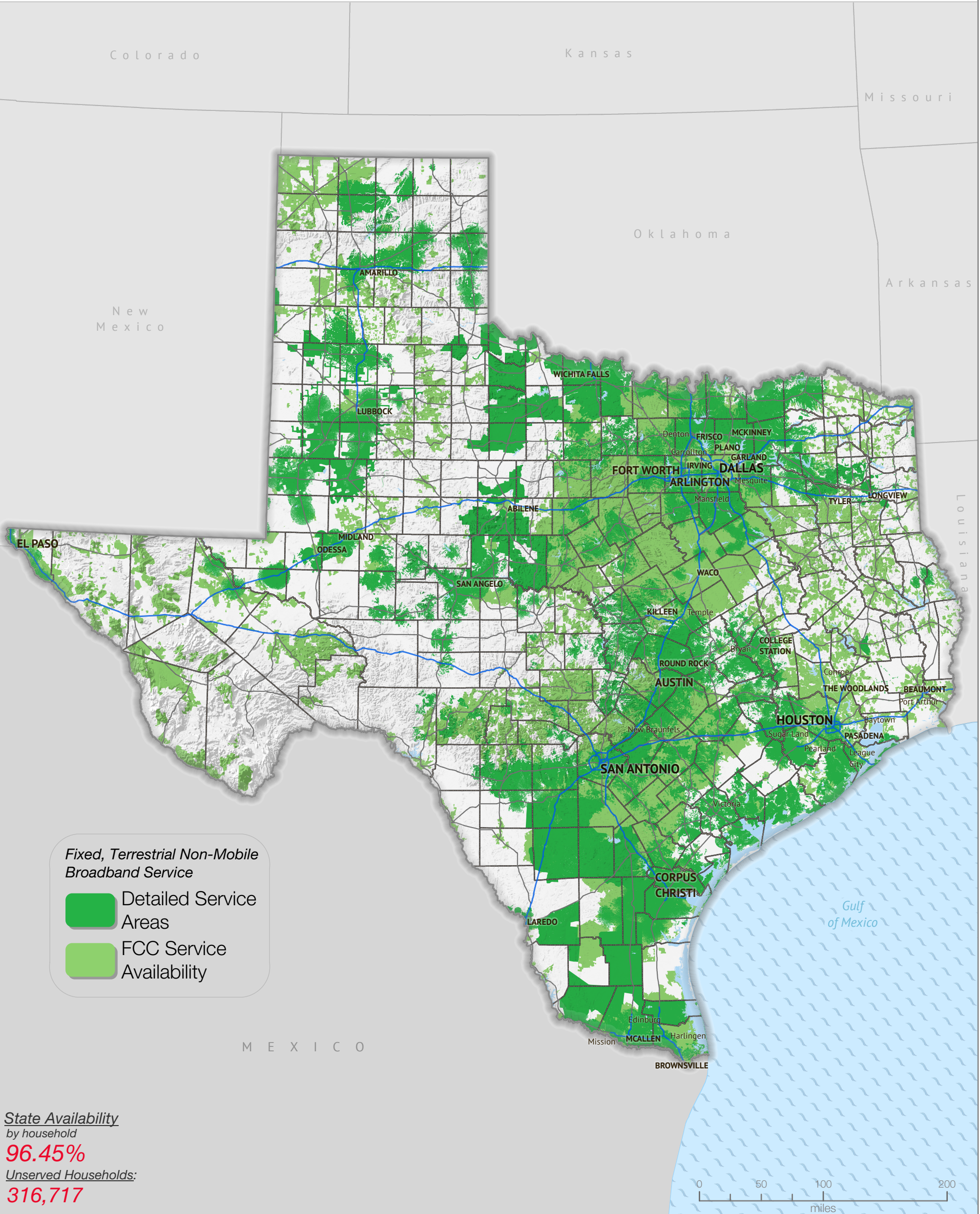


Broadband Service with Speeds of at Least 25 Mbps Download/3 Mbps Upload
